### *Artist Statement*

I grew up with a deep appreciation of the outdoors. As a kid, I enjoyed roaming “the woods” around my grandparents’ home on the shores of Lake Michigan where I was captivated by the beauty and power of that lake. When I lived in Denver in the late sixties and early seventies, I use to love going up into the Rockies, trying to “get away from it all.”

Now that I live in an area that is rich in forests, mountains, lakes, rivers, and ocean beaches, I am able to be inspired by all that nature has to give. I hope that, through my works, I am able to convey the beauty, majesty, power, and serenity of the world around me.

Most of my turnings are thin walled, to convey light and airy, floating above the chaos of our everyday existence. The form and images of the turnings try to convey the peace of the North woods to the power of the oceans to the tranquility of the garden. I want my images to bring back memories of the smell of the forest, crisp and tangy ocean sprays, the cry of the eagle as it soars through the vast blue sky. The roughness of the bark on natural edge pieces and the smoothness after finishing should stimulate not only the eyes, but the sense of touch.

### *About the Artist*

Larry has been turning since 2007, when, by chance, a wooden ship model needed a turned mast and some balusters. Never having turned, he picked up a small lathe, a couple of books, and a few DVD’s on woodturning. He attended a Woodturners of Olympia meeting and got hooked on the instant gratification of throwing a log on a lathe and completing a bowl within an hour. Soon after, he took some lessons from Larry Miller, Don Derry, and Jimmy Clewes. Inspired by the works of Binh Pho, he attended the Turn-On Chicago Symposium in 2010 and spent four sessions becoming familiar with Binh’s technique.

As a member of the Woodturners of Olympia, where he has given demos annually at their Turn & Learn Sessions, providing mentoring for other members, he currently is focusing on thin walled bowls and vases that are pierced, airbrushed and wood burned, focusing on natural subjects and wood spirits.

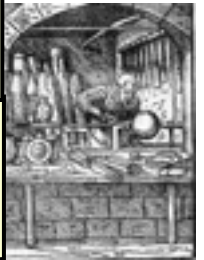

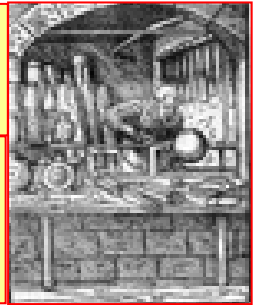
We continue to take small steps towards meeting our goals with both a youth turning program and also the Eagles Head Cane Project.

## American Association of Woodturners



To: All AAW Affiliate Local Chapters

We are pleased to inform you that a resolution has been achieved that will restore general liability insurance coverage for our AAW Chapters.

Effective by or before Tuesday, February 19th, 2013, the AAW will have bound coverage for a new commercial general liability policy. This will restore coverage in the AAW policy for all Chapters.

The terms and conditions of this policy were negotiated deliberately to obtain the best possible coverage for the AAW, for our AAW members and for our approved AAW Chapters.

However, the premium cost for this coverage has escalated significantly and the AAW will no longer be able to fully subsidize the cost of extending coverage to our Chapters.

An annual contribution of \$90 from each chapter willing to participate in the insurance plan will be required. We are allowing a 60-day grace period for Chapters to determine whether they will want to participate.

You do not need to do anything at this point to be included - all approved Chapters will immediately be insured when the coverage is bound and will remain insured during the 60-day grace period.

We are preparing a detailed description of the insurance coverage, limits and conditions, and will send it to you by Tuesday, February 19th. This information will also be available on the AAW website.

With this message we are including a one-page, [side-by-side comparison](#) of the features of this new AAW insurance policy and the optional policy plan previously made available.

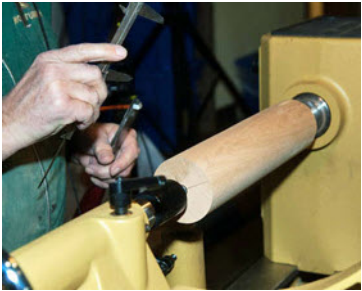

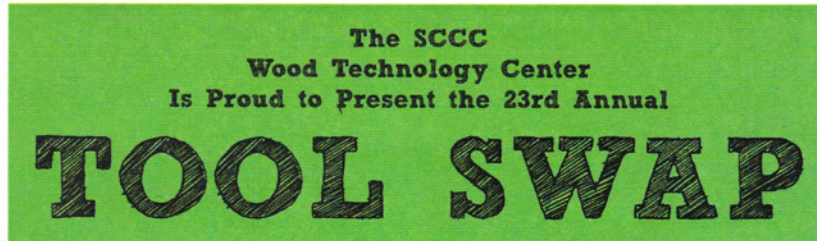

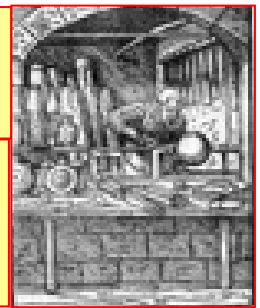
