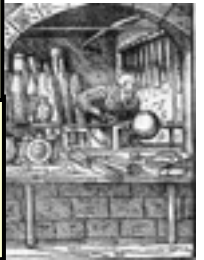

See you on the 15th.

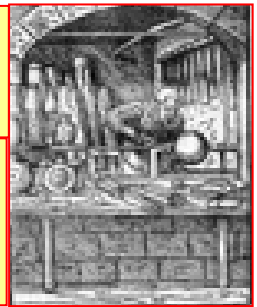
