
















WOODTURNERS OF OLYMPIA 2016 SYMPOSIUM FEATURING MICHAEL HOSALUK

SYMPOSIUM: Woodturners of Olympia 9th annual symposium featuring Michael Hosaluk with Bob Espen.

DATES: July 23, Workshops by Michael Hosaluk July 24 through 27

DESCRIPTION: The Woodturners of Olympia present their 9th annual symposium featuring world renowned Michael Hosaluk with Northwest turner Bob Espen.

Michael's demonstration will appeal to turners at all skill levels from beginner to advanced and will include, among other things, turning ladles, spatulas, bowls with enhancements, offset turning, spheres, the use of subtractive techniques to enhance your turnings, and thin turning green wood.

Michael Hosaluk is recognized internationally as one of the world's most creative wood "turners." Michael, who is an entertaining and engaging personality, is endorsed by everyone who has seen him demonstrate including three of the world recognized woodturners who provided quotes in support of our symposium:


