Enjoy Myrtle

Myrtle has a sweet scent and is a nice wood to turn. Myrtle changes name at the California border going south, it is known as Bay Laurel. It grows mainly in the coastal areas of Oregon and northern California. Cut green the wood is heavy and will not float .Slow drying is best to keep it from warping or cracking. Mother nature does a great job with it's grain and color and makes it a great wood for most any finish. In Oregon from about Florence south there are many places it can be purchased from dealers. In some forest areas it can be up to 3' in diameter and 75'or 80' tall and may be 200 years old. It also grows as a shrub or brush along river banks and road ways. It can quite often be found as drift wood on the ocean beaches.


