

Stephen Hatcher

Stephen, originally from Colorado, now lives in Olympia, Washington. He turns platters and vases from wood and then inlays mineral crystals to create images and landscapes. Combining the disparate techniques of woodturning and stone carving results in work that is unique both technically and stylistically. The pieces are made from highly figured woods, and each design is individually inspired by the natural wood figures he discovers in his materials. The inlay designs are hand carved and created with layered translucent crystals. Stephen's designs are principally inspired by the changing seasons and natural beauty of the Pacific Northwest as well as the traditional art forms of Japan.







Words of Wisdom

Almost three-quarters of professional American craft artists work in their home or on their home property-but if their studio or equipment were destroyed in a fire, hurricane or other disaster, the great majority of those artists would not be covered by insurance.

This is the conclusion of a study by the Craft Emergency Relief Fund, surveying nearly 3,000members of six national craft organizations-including the Furniture Society.

For the most part, these artists spend more than 20 hours per week doing craft-related business in their shop. Of those who own their own building, 76% think their studio is covered by their homeowners insurance, but follow up questions suggest that is only the case for less than half (36%). For non-property losses, only 30% of the artists surveyed are properly insured.

The lack of adequate business insurance represents a career-threatening financial vulnerability to craft artists who are affected by emergencies beyond their control. If you don't have an insurance 'rider' that covers artwork done on your property, then you're almost surely not covered. For the most part, we hear of people after a disaster, and too late to be thinking about insurance.
